



## **Polish - Cleaning Tips & Instructions**

Thank you for choosing Concrete Science! Enclosed are cleaning and maintenance instructions for your new flooring. Following these instructions will ensure proper care and extend the life of your floor.

Polished concrete should be dusted with a dry mop or duster as often as possible. A non-abrasive cloth is the best way to avoid damaging the surface.

Any spills that occur should be removed within the first 24 hours to prevent staining.

The surface can be cleaned with a wet cloth or mop when needed, changing the water when needed.

If a cleaner is used, we recommend a cleaning agent with neutral PH floor cleaner that is capable of suspending the dust particles so they can be cleaned.

Do not use heavy degreasers, detergents, abrasive cleaners (AJAX) , solvents or acids to clean the floor.

If there is grease or grime on the surface, it is best to apply the cleaning agent and allow it to set on the surface for a short time before trying to clean the surface. The less scrubbing that is required, the better off the polished concrete is.

Never allow cleaning solution to dry on the surface.
